In Germany, more than one in three women will experience gender-based violence in her lifetime. Statistically speaking, this amounts to more than 12 million women. Every day a man tries to kill a woman in Germany simply because of her gender. Every third day a Femicide takes place.

Violence against women and girls continues to be the most widespread violation of human rights in the world. Violence takes many forms, all of which are a reflection of unequal power relations between women and men. The majority of perpetrators around the world are male.

! Regardless of their nationality, religion, age, education or economic background, every woman and every girl can be affected.

Due to the high number of cases and the fact that less than 40 percent of women who have experienced violence seek help of any kind, gender-based violence affects the whole of society.

The International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women on 25th November marks the launch of the UN's 'Orange the World' campaign. It's aim is to raise awareness and mobilise people around the world. In Cologne, several buildings will be illuminated in orange and various events will take place throughout the city.
